Scenario Briefing

Good afternoon driver. A single FSA wagon, which has been stored in the sidings at Peterborough for some time, needs to be moved to the GBRf maintenance depot at March and you've been rostered on to this move.

You are running a little late having departed Peterborough Virtual Quarry at 15:17 instead of 14:58 and you've now encountered an adverse signal at the exit of Peterborough yard. You can proceed as soon as permitted.

Once you get permission to depart you will proceed through Peterborough station to Signal 434 where you have another booked stop. After that it is a straight run to March

Your motive power is a Class 66 and the maximum permitted speed for your train today is 60 mph.
