Scenario Briefing

Good morning driver. Today you are in charge of an early morning Thameslink service from Bedford to Brighton. You are currently at St Pancras so your first task is to release the doors to allow passengers to board and then get set-up ready to depart as soon as permitted.

On this leg of your trip you call at Farringdon, City Thameslink, Blackfriars, London Bridge, East Croydon, Gatwick Airport, Three Bridges, Balcombe, Haywards Heath, Wivelsfield, Burgess Hill, Hassocks, Preston Park and Brighton.

Up to this point you have been running on AC power but you are booked to change power type at Farringdon.

Your train is formed of a 12 car Class 700 set and the maximum permitted speed for your train today is 100 mph.
