Scenario Briefing

Good evening driver. The Master Cutler railtour (a collaboration between Retro Railtours, RailAdventure, The 125 Group and Chiltern Railways) is running today and will head from Sheffield to London as part of the 125th anniversary celebrations of Marylebone station.

You are in charge of 1Z43, the inbound service from Sheffield to Marylebone. Having left Sheffield some time ago you've now reached Tyseley where you've had a booked stop. You are currently running just over 15 minutes late so you can proceed as soon as you are ready. On this leg of your journey you are booked to stop at Banbury, West Ruislip and then, finally, Marylebone.

You are scheduled to stop at Banbury for 10 minutes and West Ruislip for 7 minutes but, because you are running late, you have been advised that you can depart as soon as each stop is complete and you receive permission to proceed.

Your train is formed of 2 HST power cars and 6 coaches and the maximum permitted speed for your train is 125 mph.
