Scenario Briefing

Good afternoon driver. The Master Cutler railtour (a collaboration between Retro Railtours, RailAdventure, The 125 Group and Chiltern Railways) is running today between Sheffield and London as part of the 125th anniversary celebrations of Marylebone station.

After the Sheffield to London part of the railtour was completed you operated a subsequent mini-tour from Marylebone to Banbury. You are now about to operate another mini-tour taking the train from Banbury back to Marylebone.

You are currently in Platform 1 at Banbury so release your doors to allow passengers to board and get ready to depart at 13:17. On this leg of your journey you have stops at Bicester North and West Ruislip only.

Your train is formed of 2 HST power cars and 6 coaches and the maximum permitted speed for your train is 125 mph.
