## Scenario Briefing

Good evening driver. Today you have been working the shuttle passenger service that runs between Marks Tey and Sudbury. You are now about to operate the last departure of the day from Sudbury but, because it is the last departure, you will be running through to Colchester rather than terminating at Marks Tey. You are currently in the platform at Sudbury so release your doors for passengers to board and get set-up ready to depart as soon as permitted.

Once underway you have station stops at Bures, Chappel and Wakes Colne, Marks Tey and Colchester.

Your train is formed of a 3 car Class 755 set and the maximum permitted speed for your train is 100 mph.
