Scenario Briefing

Good afternoon driver. The 10th Armoured Division of the Bundeswehr are currently moving some of their hardware to storage, with the mothballed military airfield at Hoch Merzburg chosen as the storage site. The equipment is being moved by train from the 10th Armoured Division's base at Veitshochheim and today you've been rostered on to one of these trains.

Having left Veitshochheim some time ago you've now reached Altenburg Nord where you've had a short wait in the sidings. Your booked wait is now complete so you can now depart as soon as you are ready. You'll be leaving your loaded wagons at the Hoch Merzburg airfield and then heading light engine to Hoch Merzburg Gbf.

You are scheduled to run under electric power but the tracks at Hoch Merzburg airfield are not electrified so you will need to switch to diesel power when you enter the airfield and then switch back to electric power when you leave the airfield to head to Hoch Merzburg Gbf.

Your motive power is a BR159 and the maximum permitted speed for your train is 100kph or 120kph when running light engine.

There is a compromise with this scenario. I've used the NS SImmnps wagons from Chris Trains but the pack is based on the Royal Netherlands Army so, for example, the Howitzer and Tank have NLD on the side which isn't accurate for a scenario portraying the equipment of the Bundeswehr. There are other military wagons packs available but the Christ Trains pack was the only one that allowed me to place the Howitzer and Tank as separate scenery items.
