Good morning driver. Today you have been rostered on to 2F06, a GWR service from Paignton to Exmouth. Having left Paignton a while ago you have now reached Exeter St Davids, so release your doors for passengers to board and get ready to depart as soon as permitted.

Once underway you have station stops at Exeter Central, St James Park, Polsloe Bridge, Digby & Sowton, Newcourt, Topsham, Exton, Lympstone Commando, Lympstone Village and Exmouth on this leg of your journey.

Your train is formed of a 2 Car Class 165 set, and the maximum permitted speed for your train is 75 mph.
