Good evening driver. Today you have been rostered on to 2T30, a GWR service from Exmouth to Paignton. You are currently in the platform at Exmouth, so release your doors for passengers to board and get ready to depart as soon as permitted.

Once underway you have station stops at Lympstone, Lympstone Commando, Exton, Topsham, Newcourt, Digby & Sowton, Polsloe Bridge, St James Park, Exeter Central and Exeter St Davids on this leg of your journey.

Your train is formed of a 2 car Class 165 set, and the maximum permitted speed for your train is 75 mph.
